By action of the WV Legislature under Legislative Rule 87-08 the WV State Fire Commission has adopted NFPA 1001, 2019 standard for Firefighter 1. WVPST is using the Jones and Bartlett curriculum. This 120-hour class provides the successful participant with certification in Firefighter 1, HazMat Awareness and Operations (which meets the 2017 NFPA 1072 requirements), and First Aid & CPR. The Legislative Rule also requires that HazMat Operations level training is a requirement to receive Firefighter 1 certification. Live Fire Training that meets the NFPA requirements for FF 1 training is also required for Firefighter 1 Certification.
