By action of the WV Legislature under Legislative Rule 87-08 the WV State Fire Commission has adopted NFPA 1001, 2019 standard for Fire Fighter 2. This 40-hour class will meet the requirements of the 2019 NFPA standard. WVPST is using the Jones and Bartlett curriculum. The Legislative Rule also establishes that any active firefighter who has completed Fire Fighter 2 is deemed to have met the minimum requirement for Vehicle Rescue. Fire Fighter 1 is prerequisite for enrollment in Fire Fighter 2.
