EMT TRAINING ACADEMY

This is our first EMT training academy for our emergency squad. This academy will consist of getting the selected individuals certified as an Emergency Vehicle Operator. With this certification you will be able to run on an ambulance with our crews and learn while you are in class. You will be trained to operate an ambulance and assist the paramedic or EMT in the patient compartment. This will be beneficial while you train for your EMT.

This EMT course is a blending learning course. You will complete most of your work on-line and we will meet throughout the months of September through early December. During this time you will have to complete 10 patient ride-a-longs, where you will be the primary care provider while you are supervised by a EMT or Paramedic. You will get certified in emergency vehicle operator course, HAZMAT, mass casualty incident, BLS protocol course and HIPPA.

This EMT course is completely free of charge. We were awarded an Emergency Management Award from the WV Higher Education Policy Commission. This is part of Governor Justice's EMS initiative that he started to help EMS around the state recruit and retain EMS personnel.

What we need from you is dedication and the heart to serve you community. You must have compassion and be self-driven to succeed in this academy. There will be part and full time job opening at the squad in the months to come. If selected to join our academy you will have to sign a contract that you will work part or full time for us over the next two years. We take this academy seriously and if you are not looking to join our team then please don't apply. If you feel this is a career for you, then complete an application and return it to us by August 26, 2022.

If selected, plan to attend your first class week of September 5, 2022. Day is yet to be announced.
